

CONFERENCE FLOOR PLAN

Conference Location

The conference will utilize the Verona Room, 3rd floor/level of hotel, for the Friday Night Networking/Social Event, and three adjoining rooms, Naples I, II, and III for conference workshops on the first floor of the hotel on both Saturday November 15th, 2014, and Sunday November 16th, 2014. The exhibitor tables will be located on the first floor vestibule (lobby directly in front of Naples I, II, and III). The Saturday luncheon will be located in the Sicilian Ballroom, 2nd floor/level of hotel.

TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORTS

Los Angeles Airport (LAX)

- 1. Exit LAX on Century Blvd. (East)
- 2. Take 405 South toward San Diego (approx. 20 minutes)
- 3. Follow directions below from 710 South:

Long Beach Airport (LGB)

- 1. Exit the airport on Donald Douglas Drive
- 2. Turn right at Lakewood Blvd.
- 3. Take 405 North toward Los Angeles (approx. 3 miles)
- 4. Follow directions below from 710 South:

John Wayne Orange County Airport (SNA)

- 1. Exit airport onto MacArthur Boulevard (two left hand lanes)
- 2. Merge to the right lanes to take 405 North toward Los Angeles (15 miles)
- 3. Follow directions below from 710 South as follows:

From 710 South:

- 1. Take 710 South toward Long Beach; stay to the left and follow the signs to Downtown
- 2. Exit Broadway which is a one-way street and is a left side exit lane of freeway
- 3. Proceed on Pine south approx. 2 blocks just past First Street
- 4. Hotel entrance is the last driveway on the left side before Ocean Boulevard

DIRECTIONS FROM METRO BLUE LINE TRAIN STATION:

- 1. Take Metro Blue Line south towards Long Beach and exit Downtown Long Beach (Pine Avenue and 1st Street).
- 2. Walk south one block south on Pine Avenue towards Ocean Boulevard. Renaissance Hotel is on northeast corner of Pine Avenue and Ocean Boulevard.
