Key Responsibilities:

- Researchs relevant legislative developments, both the state and federal level.
- Makes recommendations about actions that CAOMS can take to support key legislation.
- Presents a brief verbal summary at each CAOMS meeting.
- Provides a written summary for inclusion in the CAOMS meeting minutes.

Qualifications:

Ability to

- Contact key informants.
- Access the internet to obtain information.
- Write brief reports.
- Communicate verbally.

Time Commitment & Location:

- Time: 15-30 minutes, 3 times a year
- Location: teleconference from the location of your choice
